With Homecoming 2008 quickly approaching, the University would like to take this opportunity to help make your travels to, through and from campus less stressful and more predictable during the event. Howard University is committed to providing a world class and memorable experience during the days of Homecoming 2008. Understanding your transportation options during the event is one component of that goal.

Parking: HU will provide limited, **free premier parking** to game and event attendees (after the parade) who **carpool with four or more people** in their car. This free parking will be located in the **Miner Parking Lot**, located close to Greene Memorial Stadium at 2402 6th St. NW. This parking will exist on a first come, first served basis. All other event parking will be located in the following lots: Howard Center, Banneker North and South, East and West Towers and Bethune Annex.

Shuttle service: Howard will provide **shuttle service** from both the **Shaw-Howard University Metro Station** as well as the **Georgia Avenue-Petworth Station** to the Banneker South Parking Lot beginning at 8:50am and every 40 minutes after that (depending on traffic). Help us relieve congestion at Shaw-Howard Metro and consider riding to Georgia Ave-Petworth Metro.

Saturday Night Step Show: After the game on Saturday, the best way the Stadium Armory for the step show is Metro. HU Shuttles will provide service to Shaw-Howard Metro along with Georgia Ave- Petworth station so visitors can get to the show quickly.
