<p><b>Medical Assistance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students can go to the Howard University Hospital for medical services.</li> <li>• The Student Health Center can provide health services and referrals.</li> <li>• A Sexual Assault Exam is available at Washington Hospital Center. The exam includes preventive treatment for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy and evidence collection. The exam is conducted by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) who is a Registered Nurse with advanced training and certification in conducting sexual assault exams. The Network for Victim Recovery of DC (NVRDC) provides advocates on site.</li> <li>• A rape kit and examination can be done for free at Howard University Hospital or Washington Hospital Center</li> <li>• A police report is <u>not</u> required to receive medical assistance</li> </ul>	<p><b>Advocacy, Support Services, Housing &amp; Academic Accommodations</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Interpersonal Violence Prevention Program (IVPP) provides information, referrals and can connect students with an advocate (*<b>confidential source</b>).</li> <li>• The Office of Student Services assists with academic and housing accommodations, referrals, disciplinary and judicial affairs.</li> <li>• University Counseling Services provides individual and group counseling and psychotherapy, crisis intervention and consultation (*<b>confidential source</b>).</li> <li>• The Office of Residence Life can assist with housing accommodations.</li> <li>• DC Rape Crisis Center provides a crisis line, 24-hour advocacy, and counseling services.</li> <li>• My Sisters Place provides a 24-hour crisis line and counseling services.</li> </ul> <p><b>Emergency Services</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Howard University Department of Public Safety provides 24-hour emergency services.</li> <li>• Students can also call 911 for 24-hour emergency services from the Metropolitan Police Department.</li> </ul>
