FIRST TIME IN COLLEGE APPLICANTS: (FRESHMAN)

A student who has never been admitted to a degree program at Howard University or any other post-secondary institution of higher education (first time in college).

We consider the applicant's secondary school academic record, standardized college entrance exams (SAT or ACT), leadership in school and community activities, unique talents and skills, and educational objectives. For admission consideration, an applicant should have a well-balanced college preparatory program that includes the following course work:

- 4 years English
- 3 years mathematics
- 2 years social science
- 2 years science (w/ lab)
- 2 years foreign language

To expedite processing, ask your High School Concelor to mail the complete application package to Howard University.

Complete application package includes:

- * Completed, signed, and dated application for admission
- * \$45 non-refundable admission application fee payable by money order, cashier's check, or credit card
(Credit card authorization form enclosed)
- Personal checks are not accepted.**
- NOTE: Howard University does not waive application fees.**
- * Official high school transcript that shows your cumulative grade point average and class rank (from 9th-11th grade)
- * Standardized test scores
- * One letter of recommendation from a teacher
- * One letter of recommendation from a counselor
- * Admission essay

TRANSFER APPLICANTS:

A student who has attended another post-secondary institution of higher education and who may seek admission to Howard University with advanced standing. In general, a transfer student must transfer a minimum of 15 credit hours from a regionally accredited post-secondary institution, have earned a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and received a passing grade of C or better in both a college-level English and college-level Math course. School of Business transfer applicants must earn at least 30 credit hours with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

Complete application package includes:

- * Completed application for admission
- * One letter of recommendation from a college professor
- * 2 copies of official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- * \$45 admission application fee

Transcripts must include grades through your last semester of enrollment. Admission criteria vary among Howard University's schools and colleges.

FORMER STUDENTS RETURNING:

A matriculating student who was pursuing a degree at Howard University; who has not been registered at the University for the previous semester. Former students who have not obtained a degree, or who have not completed an official intra-university transfer process, must return to the same school/college, department, and degree program. Former Students who wish to return to the University must be in good standing for re-admission or receive permission from the Howard University school/college where last enrolled to be re-admitted.

Complete application package includes:

- * If you have been away from Howard University for a semester or more, you must submit a completed application for admission by the same deadline date as traditional undergraduate applicants.
- * Submit 2 copies of official transcript from each college or university attended since leaving Howard.

Applicants will be readmitted to the program in which they were last enrolled.

Proof of Residence: Resident Aliens and Permanent Residents must submit one of the following documents: A copy of a valid Residence Alien Card (Green Card) or U.S. Passport. Naturalized Citizens: Current Naturalization document (Copy of Marriage Certificate) Asylee: A valid copy of asylum certificate and address of foreign country.

EXCHANGE STUDENTS:

A student who is enrolled at another institution and through an official exchange agreement is approved to take courses on a non-matriculating basis at Howard University.

Students may exchange only to and from campuses that are members of the National Student Exchange (NSE). Applicants must be full-time students at the home campus at the time of application. Interested applicants should consult with their home campus NSE coordinator for additional information.

STUDENT-AT-LARGE

A non-matriculating student who is applying to attend 'summer semester only' at Howard University. Student-At-Large are required to submit a completed application for admission.

UNCLASSIFIED STUDENT

A non-matriculating student who wishes to take courses during a traditional fall or spring semester. In general, unclassified students, take a limited number of classes for personal or career advancement, or as pre-requisites for specialized educational programs.

Unclassified students are not eligible for financial aid or University housing. Enrollment size may restrict the ability to accommodate unclassified students during the fall and spring semesters.

POST - BACCALAUREATE/DEGREE

A student who has already obtained a bachelor's degree and is interested in pursuing a second bachelor's degree. An application is required along with official transcripts and letters of recommendations.

VISITING STUDENTS:

A student who is currently enrolled at another institution but wishes to enroll at Howard University on a non-matriculating basis for one academic year or less.

Complete application package includes:

Visiting students who plan to enroll at Howard University must complete and submit the following:

- * Application for Admission
- * Nonrefundable \$45 application fee, paid by money order, cashier's check, or credit card only.
- * At least a 2.50 GPA
- * Official transcript
- * A letter of permission from the home school. The letter should include the student's GPA and a list of courses the student is authorized to take. Applications will not be processed until such letter is received.

All documents must be received by EM/Admission by the designated deadline.

Admitted students who intend to enroll at Howard University pay a \$300 non-refundable enrollment fee by May 1st to secure their place in the class. Visiting students are considered for housing once they have been accepted and have submitted an application for housing and a \$50 housing application fee (*housing is not guaranteed*).

Visiting students can matriculate for a maximum of one academic year.

ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

If you are applying to the division of Fine Arts, your application must be supplemented with the following:

With the exception of fashion merchandising, art history, and art management majors, prospective **art majors** must submit slide portfolios of 12 examples of work with no more than two views of any one work. Slides should be submitted in a plastic sleeve; clearly marked with the title of the work, materials used, size, date of completion, and applicant's name. Prospective **dance majors** must complete an intensive, five-day audition. The applicant's technical and written work will be evaluated before the dance major is confirmed. For more information, call the Department of Theatre Arts at 202-806-7050.

Prospective **music majors** must present a voice or instrument audition, scheduled by appointment only. Cassette tapes will be accepted from those unable to audition. For more information, call the Department of Music at 202-806-7082.

Prospective **theatre arts majors** must present an audition, portfolio, and/or interview as evidence of the ability to successfully pursue college-level work in theatre arts. For more information, or a schedule of appointments for auditions, portfolio reviews, and interviews, call the Department of Theatre Arts at 202-806-7050.

FINANCIAL AID

The Office of Financial Aid, Scholarships, and Student Employment offers a comprehensive financial aid program that attempts to meet the financial needs of all Howard University students. First time in college students should apply for early action admission to be considered for several available freshman scholarships. All U.S. citizens, eligible non-citizens, and permanent residents must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year. Applicants must list Howard University and its code (001448) as the college they plan to attend. The University's deadline for priority consideration is February 15th. Non-U.S. citizens on temporary visas are not eligible for federal aid but may be eligible for assistance through the University's grants, scholarships, or student employment programs.
