## MISSION

The mission of Howard University as a comprehensive, research-oriented, predominantly African-American university is to provide an educational experience of exceptional quality at reasonable cost to students of high academic potential. Particular emphasis is placed upon providing educational opportunities for African-American men and women and for other historically disenfranchised groups. Furthermore, Howard University is dedicated to attracting, sustaining, and developing a cadre of faculty who, through their teaching and research, are committed to producing distinguished and compassionate graduates who seek solutions to human and social problems in the United States and throughout the world.

## STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK FOR ACTION

In 1995, under the leadership of H. Patrick Swygert, the University began a robust process of reflection that would reaffirm the core values of the University to provide Leadership for America and the Global Community, and serve as a blueprint for its successful transition to the 21st Century. The ambitious agenda that came out of that process became known as the Strategic Framework for Action (SFA). The initiative began with the mission, core values and vision of the University clearly articulated and endorsed by the community.

In March, 2000, strengthened in its resolve to enhance and build on the achievements of SFA, Howard University began a new strategic planning initiative, the Strategic Framework for Action II (SFA II). After Board approval of its goals, a 30-member University Advisory Committee consisting of twenty-five faculty members drawn from all the schools and colleges, two students and three administrative staff was appointed. The Strategic Framework for Action II consists of four overarching goals:

- Strengthening Academic Programs and Services
- Promoting Excellence in Teaching and Research
- Increasing Private Support
- Enhancing National and Community Service

The University will enhance its legacy of Leadership for America and the Global Community by focusing on thirty-one projects in four strategic areas:

## STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK FOR ACTION

### Strengthening Academic Programs and Services

1. Build the Interdisciplinary Science and Engineering Center.
2. Co-locate a federal research activity.
3. Establish additional public and private strategic partnerships.
4. Build a replacement facility for the School of Communications and provide an appropriate facility for the School of Education.
5. Join the Internet2 Consortium.
6. Provide access to appropriate computing resources for every Howard University student.
7. ResNet2: Complete wiring of all residence halls for voice, data and video.
8. Complete the Howard University Television campus network and convert WHUT-TV from analog to digital technology.
9. Enhance campus-wide wireless capacity.
10. Digitize essential information and build requisite infrastructure to facilitate asynchronous education.
11. Recalibrate administrative and student support operations to the Internet.
12. Build a comprehensive Health, Recreation and Student Life facility designed to support intramural as well as intercollegiate athletic activities, and to improve and maintain the health and physical activity of the student body.
13. Build capacity for 1,000 additional parking spaces.

### **Promoting Excellence in Teaching and Research**

14. Restructure the Office of Research Administration.
15. Develop a coherent incentive system for faculty research.
16. Strengthen the research professorship track.
17. Increase the number of endowed chairs.
18. Increase the number and amount of graduate student stipends.
19. Create new interdisciplinary research groups.
20. Encourage the faculty to pursue memberships in National Academies based on faculty honors and achievements in research, publications and pedagogy. Recognize such memberships publicly.
21. Upgrade FacNet equipment.
22. Develop collaborations and establish stronger academic linkages and professional peer interactions with other leading universities and colleges.
23. Establish a Teaching and Learning Center.
24. Develop a plan for the Howard University North Campus in Beltsville, Maryland.

### **Increasing Private Support**

25. Initiate a major Capital Campaign during Fiscal Year 2002.

### **Enhancing National and Community Service**

26. Continue to invest in Howard University Hospital's capacity to provide area residents with high quality healthcare, independent of their ability to pay.

27. Develop a new practice plan for clinical faculty in the College of Medicine.
28. Create the Howard University Center for Public Service.
29. Develop Phase 2 of the LeDroit Park Initiative.

## HISTORY

In November 1866, shortly after the end of the Civil War, members of The First Congregational Society of Washington considered establishing a theological seminary for the education of African-American clergymen. Within a few weeks, the concept had expanded to include a provision for establishing a university. Within two years, the University consisted of the Colleges of Liberal Arts and Medicine. The new institution was named for General Oliver O. Howard, Civil War hero, who was both a founder of the University and, at the time, Commissioner of the Freedmen's Bureau.

The University charter, as enacted by Congress and subsequently approved by President Andrew Johnson on March 2, 1867, designated Howard University as “a university for the education of youth in the liberal arts and sciences.”

In 1879, Congress approved a special appropriation for the University. The charter was amended in 1928 to authorize an annual federal appropriation for construction, development, improvement and maintenance of the University.

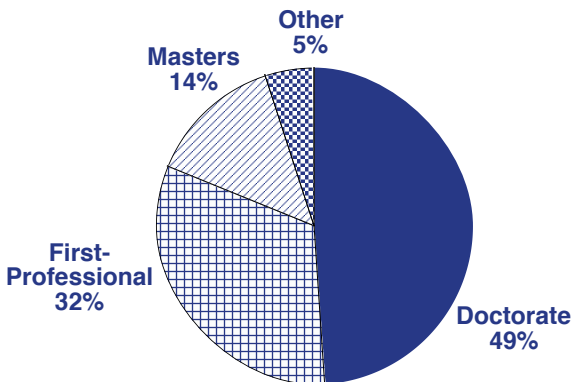

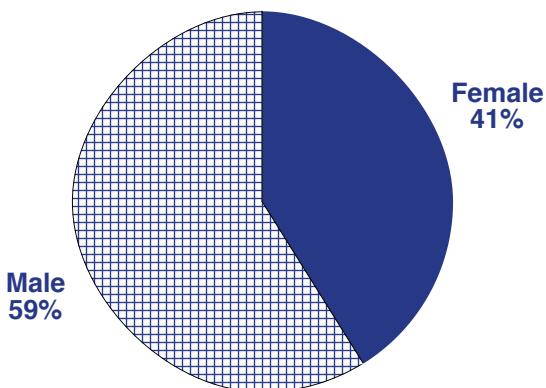
### Earned Degrees

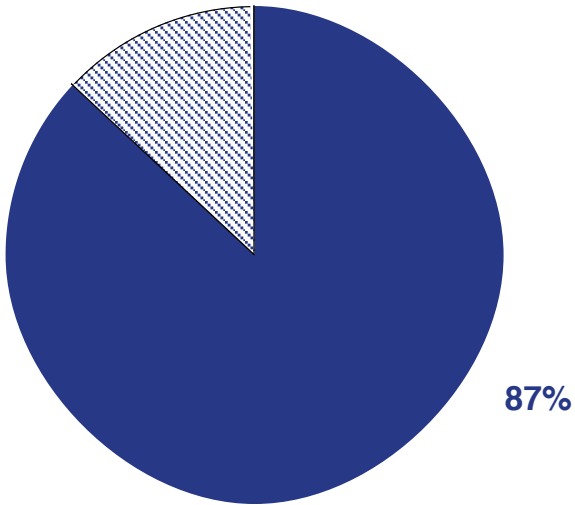

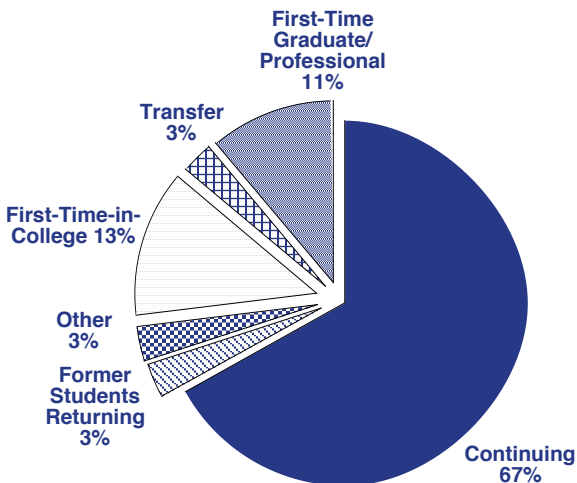

## Enrollment Status of Students

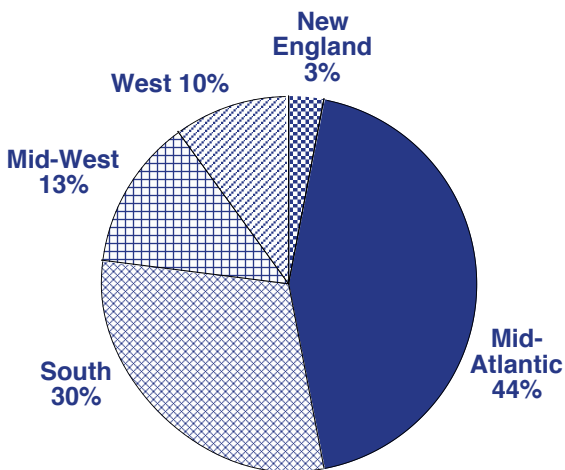


## Enrollment by Degree

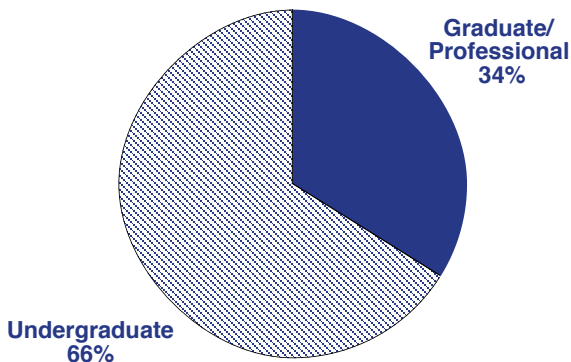

### Campus

Since its founding, Howard University has grown from a single frame building to 107 buildings on five campuses. The University has many academic programs designed to make use of the resources unique to Washington, DC. The White House, the Capitol, Embassy Row and most of the cultural and historic institutions of the city are within minutes of the main campus.

The University Center includes an art gallery; a recreation center with twelve bowling lanes; meeting and conference rooms; dining facilities (restaurant, cafeteria and snack bar); a digital auditorium; a 1500-person capacity ballroom; lounges; and student government and administrative offices. University Center facilities are often enjoyed by the metropolitan Washington, DC community.

In the last few years the University has completed several important capital improvements to the campus. The Ralph J. Bunche International Affairs Center; the Technology Center, headquarters for the University's information systems infrastructure; Howard Hall, the original residence of founder General Oliver O. Howard; and Childers Hall, which serves the University's fine arts students, are four illustrative examples. In 2001, the University opened 2 new digital libraries: the Louis Stokes Health Sciences Library on the Main Campus and the Law School Library on the West Campus.

**The Howard University Community Association** is the principal point of contact between the University and the community-at-large. It is the locus for ongoing University planning efforts regarding neighboring LeDroit Park and the Georgia Avenue Corridor. It also houses

the University's AmeriCorps, Jumpstart, and Project C.H.A.N.G.E. programs. On a daily basis, it provides information and referral services about University events, programs and activities. It also provides the University family with information about important community events and initiatives.

**The Howard University/Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) Joint Security Station** is the first of its kind in the District of Columbia where the Metropolitan Police Department shares a facility with a private entity. The station facilitates a direct working relationship between the MPD and University Security, and provides logistical support to the officers assigned to the area. It is intended to be a focal point for crime prevention and law enforcement in the Howard University community and its surrounding neighborhood.

**Middle School of Mathematics and Science (MS)<sup>2</sup>** Howard University is committed to action that will help to prepare our youngsters for a rapidly changing economy and workforce that is so dependent on science, engineering and technology. Because research reveals that the disparity of African Americans and other people of color engaged in these fields begins at the middle school level, the University establish the Howard University Middle School of Mathematics and Science, the first charter school in DC to be established by a university.

The Middle School opened its doors on August 29, 2005 to 120 sixth graders who come from seven of the eight wards in the city. It is a technology-enabled school designed specifically for middle school students with the benefit of being located on a research university campus. It offers a rigorous core curriculum in Math,

Science, Social Studies, Language Arts and Spanish. It also provides an Accelerated Learning Program focusing on individualized student instructional needs, and an Extended Day Program offering a variety of co-curricular activities, such as Digital Media, Chorus and Music Theory, Chess and introductory Chinese.

Each student was provided a laptop computer for use in the classroom and a second one for use at home, and every household has been provided with broadband internet access. Every classroom has a specially designed high definition plasma display onto which students and teachers can project their work.

Seventeen University undergraduate and graduate students from the Schools of Education and Business, the College of Arts and Sciences, and the Graduate School are assisting (MS)<sup>2</sup> as teaching aides, tutors and mentors.

Students have had an opportunity to attend academically enriching educational field trips around the City, visiting the Rain Forest exhibit at the National Zoo, the French Embassy, and the Kennedy Center.

Of particular note is that a majority of the MS<sup>2</sup> faculty and staff are Howard alumni, or have significant family ties to the University.

### **Information Systems**

The University added worldwide webcasting to its broadcasting of all major events in 1994 when the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the President of the Republic of South Africa both visited. A major address by the United Nations Secretary General

and the Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission made the practice routine.

In addition to closed-circuit audio and video networks, Howard University has two FCC-licensed broadcast stations (a public television station and a high-definition commercial radio station). Both use satellite technology.

The University also has a campus-wide fiber-optic, fast gigabit, wide area TCP/IP network. Our main meeting areas are videoconference-capable, with local fiber and ISDN providing compliant conference standards. Fixed seating is wired for data and power. There are sections for left-handed persons, as well as those who are physically challenged.

There are also eTheatres with the ability to project overhead slides and high-resolution photography, and smartboards capable of direct access, electronic storage and projection. The audiovisual components are capable of DVD viewing and theatre room presentation of Web offerings. Sixteen millimeter projectors provide 'cinema'-quality video and studio quality sound.

Textual, video, audio, and data streams of information can be collaborated on simultaneously. Video and voice can be digitally converted over the network backbone to a satellite uplink and then to remote locations. Discrete locations can establish a "forum" to utilize the University's Voice Over IP capabilities.

Each full-time faculty member has an Internet-ready computer, and their offices are wired to provide connectivity to the Howard University network, the

Internet and the Worldwide Web. The University has continued its commitment to maintaining technological currency by initiating regular upgrades of Macintosh and PC workstations for faculty.

The Howard University received a large program grant of over 1,700 software titles from Microsoft. The grant, which has been renewed each year, enables software to be made available to all Howard University students, faculty and staff free of charge on a cross-campus basis for instructional and research use.

### **The iLab**

The Information Laboratory at the Technology Center (iLab) is a very attractive facility that seats up to 200 simultaneous computer users at a variety of computing platforms. Each computer in this facility is connected, via a broadband network, to all of the student-available computing resources of the University, in addition to the vast resources on the Internet. Students may travel to and from the iLab via regularly scheduled shuttle buses that operate between the residence halls, various academic buildings and the iLab.

Students using the iLab have access to televised information displayed on monitors in clear view from any seat in the facility. At each seat in the facility is a wireless sound system that can be tuned to any of the television monitors or to a variety of music programs designed to meet a diverse set of personal tastes.

The iLab has garnered a great deal of attention from both television news and print media, and has even served as the backdrop for high technology project announcements, such as the NBC4 Internet portal initiation.

### **Center for Excellence in Teaching, Learning and Assessment**

Co-located with the iLab is the Center for Excellence in Teaching, Learning and Assessment which serves as a facility for faculty use in the development of modern teaching techniques, including multimedia presentations for the classroom and distance learning techniques. The Center offers training and refresher sessions for faculty on a variety of software applications relevant to teaching, learning and assessment.

### **University Center Commuter Computer Lab**

Located in the lower level of the Blackburn Center, the Commuter Computer Lab was established in September 2002 and makes available nearly forty networked computers in an attractive learning environment for commuting students. Each computer is equipped with the standard set of productivity software, including Microsoft Office. All systems automatically update virus definitions and run scans daily to maintain operational status. During the academic year, the Lab operates Monday through Friday from 12 Noon to 10:00 p.m. All students are welcome to use this high-tech facility.

### **Student Residential Network (ResNet)**

The University also maintains a significant enabling technology presence in the residence halls. In addition to the iLab and the Commuter Computer Lab, the University operates smaller computer laboratories that are located in each of eleven residence halls. These facilities allow students to access the computing resources of the University and the Internet without having to leave their residence halls. This wireless network allows students to install wireless network interface cards in their computers and have access on a 24/7 basis to all campus computing resources, plus the Internet, from their rooms.

The University expanded this access even further when it completed a major technology upgrade—ResNet2—which provides wired network access, cable TV and new telephone service to each individual resident. These additional services are provided in each every dormitory.

The wired network enables students to access all of the services on the University's network and on the Internet at 100 MB per second. The cable TV service enables access to 50 channels of entertainment and news programming, including WHUT-TV and several Howard University programming and information channels. The upgraded telephone service gives each resident a dedicated phone line with voice mail, speed dial, and 3-way calling. When coupled with existing computer laboratories and wireless network services, a comprehensive array of technology services is accessible to all students in every residence hall.

### **eStops**

Strategically placed eStops provide yet another access point for students. In seven locations around the campus, four kiosks at each stop provide students with convenient access to their Email accounts. From any of these locations, students may send or receive Email from their accounts. At each eStop location, video monitors provide students with pertinent information from the WHUT-TV network as well as three other television news sources.

### **Digital Auditorium**

The University Center's Digital Auditorium provides students with direct access to the campus-wide fiber optic network. The auditorium is videoconference-capable, with high-speed fiber connections on campus,

and ISDN providing standard wide-area conferencing capability. Each of the 140 seats in the auditorium is wired for data connection and power.

The Digital Auditorium includes an eTheatre with the ability to project overhead slides, high-resolution photography and streaming digital video. The room is also capable of DVD presentations, as well as the full variety of offerings from the World Wide Web.

### Smart Classrooms

There are 42 smart classrooms located in various academic buildings across the campus. Each smart classroom contains high-end, integrated audio-visual presentation and production capabilities, including a smart board, an automated instructor station, and network capable student seating. Smart classrooms also provide access to the University's distance learning resources, and to the Internet.

### **HOWARD UNIVERSITY** **TELEVISION**

Founded in 1980, Howard University Television, WHUT-TV, was the first African-American-owned public television station in the nation. It is also the only university-licensed public television station located in the metropolitan Washington viewing area, which includes more than two million households. In addition to broadcasting important University events to the influential metropolitan Washington area community, Howard University Television provides a diverse mix of news, information and programming that is unavailable elsewhere.

Howard University Television facilitates national and international distribution of key University activities.

In addition, major University events are webcast for access around the world. The campus-wide video network enhances Howard University Television's capacity to capture University speakers, athletic and cultural events and Rankin Chapel services. The closed-circuit system will be expanded to allow distribution to classrooms, academic buildings and residence halls throughout the campus.

Annually, the station provides comprehensive, hands-on training to students in such areas as communications, business, engineering, law and the fine arts. Students trained at Howard University Television can be found working as media professionals throughout the industry from coast to coast. In 2004, the National Association of Broadcasting presented Howard University with the prestigious "Spirit of Broadcasting" award.



### Howard University Radio

The University's commercial radio station, WHUR-FM (96.3), has been broadcasting for more than 35 years and is a leading station in the Washington metropolitan area. It is also the first and only station in the area to broadcast high definition radio.

The radio station has a clinical relationship with University faculty and students, especially those in Business, Communications, and Engineering. The station is well respected for services to the greater Washington community.

Among the many community services rendered by WHUR-FM are Project Harvest (an annual drive to feed the needy during Thanksgiving); Give Me Shelter, a 12-

hour radiothon to raise money to help shelter victims of domestic violence; and an annual coat and toy drive to benefit disadvantaged children.

WHUR-FM has been honored by the National Association of Broadcasters Education Foundation with its Service to America Radio Partnerships Award.

### **WHBC**

With assistance from WHUR-FM, WHBC, a student-run radio station, provides music, news and sports to campus dormitories. The station recently celebrated its 30th anniversary.

### **Howard University Hospital**

Howard University Hospital has been a provider of quality healthcare for nearly 144 years. It has been cited by U.S. News & World Report as one of the nation's best hospitals. Howard University Hospital remains a pioneer in treatment techniques and ranks high in the community in the detection and treatment of heart disease, cancer, organ transplantation, travel medicine, neonatal care, shock trauma, geriatrics and other areas of medicine and surgery. Its physicians have been ranked among the best doctors by Washingtonian Magazine, Black Enterprise Magazine and by prestigious national organizations such as the American Heart Association. The only major teaching hospital in the nation located on an historically black university campus, Howard University Hospital remains committed to providing quality accessible healthcare for all.

### **Howard University Research Building I**

The Howard University Research Building I (HURB I) is a prototype research facility that accommodates the activities of major externally-funded research projects directed at the development of solutions to enduring problems, especially

those that disproportionately impact people of color. It provides a foundation and forum for research-based curriculum and policy development, practice intervention, best practices, and subsequent dissemination of research findings.

Housing a significant community of research staff, faculty and students, the 50,000 square-foot facility is located along the Georgia Avenue corridor, symbolizing Howard University's role as an active institutional partner in the revitalization and development of the community.

### **University Libraries**

The University Libraries System consists of a central library complex, located in the Founders Library and the contiguous Undergraduate Library building; and branch units in the Schools of Architecture and Design, Business, Divinity, and Social Work. Other campus information and resource facilities include the Moorland-Spingarn Research Center, the Afro-American Studies Resource Center, and the International Affairs Library. The Founders Library, named in memory of the seventeen founders of the University, and designed by the famed African-American architect Albert I. Cassell, opened in 1938.

In 2001, the University opened two new 80,000 square foot digital libraries, The Louis Stokes Health Sciences Library on the Main Campus and the School of Law Library on the West Campus. The Louis Stokes Health Sciences Library is a world-class research facility for health care professionals, outfitted with modern telecommunication and audiovisual capabilities. The building accommodates 630 individuals, with all seats wired for power and data. In addition, there are a number of flexible presentation rooms, distance learning labs, a telemedicine room and

an exhibit gallery. It provides for a book collection of over 215,000 volumes and seats for nearly 300 students. It has 90 open carrels, with all locations wired for computer use; enlarged microform and audiovisual facilities; and distinctive rooms for special collections, newspaper and periodical reading, as well as a Rare Book Collection and a triple reading room.

The mission of the University Libraries is to provide innovative, effective information services and products that support, strengthen, and advance teaching/learning and research in the University community. The library system has large and comprehensive resources incorporating virtually every discipline, supported by information specialists and technical personnel. Holdings include more than 2 million volumes, over 12,000 current social titles, 3.4 million microforms, and a rich multimedia collection. Most library facilities are open seven days a week during each semester. Materials which are not in the collection can be obtained through various inter-institutional cooperative arrangements.

The libraries' collections of traditional materials are complemented by a strong and continually updated digital component. Online Web-based catalogs provide quick access to library holdings. The website is a virtual library of local and global resources via the Internet, with thousands of full-text journals, bibliographic databases, reference tools, data files and multimedia, accessible 24/7 from library, dorm, office, and home. Electronic facilities include a fiber infrastructure, over two hundred fully networked workstations, laser printers, and a 22-desktop digital learning classroom. Howard University is a member of the Association of Research Libraries, the Chesapeake Information and Research Library Alliance, as well as a number of regional and national organizations.

### **Howard University Bookstore**

The Howard University Bookstore stocks textbooks, general books, academic supplies, apparel, gifts, greeting cards, computer hardware and software and ethnic art. It also offers professional framing services. Many items are available for purchase on its website. The store features a Starbucks, where students may surf the net while enjoying their favorite refreshment.

The Bookstore frequently hosts author signings and events. It currently operates in two locations: the Main Campus and the School of Law Campus.

### **Howard University Press**

Established in 1972, Howard University Press is the publishing arm of the nation's premier historically black Research Extensive university. The Press supports its parent institution's goal of "providing leadership for America and the Global Community" by publishing noteworthy new scholarship that addresses the contributions, conditions, and concerns of African Americans, other people of African descent, and people of color around the world. The Press welcomes crosscutting, foundational research that advances and deepens knowledge in its areas of focus from a variety of perspectives. It publishes books in a broad array of disciplines, including (but not limited to) African diasporic studies, political, economic, and social sciences; history; education; science, health, and technology; literature and drama studies; communications; and the arts.

### The Campaign for Howard

The Campaign for Howard was launched in March 2002, in commemoration of the founding of the University in 1867. The goal of The Campaign is to raise \$250 million in five years. To date, \$215 million has been raised in cash and commitments, excluding the very generous \$70.6 million received through the General Motors PACE program. This total represents 86% of the Campaign objective.

Tuition, corporate funding and federal support are the three principal sources of revenue for Howard University. Although federal support has been consistently strong, it alone could not ensure the University's future excellence. The University's agenda anticipates building stronger strategic partnerships with corporations. Corporate funding, however, is usually restricted.

At virtually all American colleges and universities, the tuition charged is less than what it actually costs to educate a student. This is especially true at Howard. The University is committed to access as well as excellence and, although every effort is made to keep tuition as low as possible, the vast majority of the University's students demonstrate a need for financial aid. Closing the gap requires significant new private support from individuals and corporations.

The objectives of the Campaign are:

#### STRENGTHENING ACADEMIC PROGRAMS: \$125 MILLION

- To promote excellence through the development of endowed faculty positions in areas of strategic importance.

## FINANCES

### RENEWING FACILITIES FOR TEACHING AND RESEARCH: \$75 MILLION

- To create appropriate physical infrastructure in support of teaching and research.

### ENHANCING THE LEARNING COMMUNITY: \$50 MILLION

- To provide graduate student stipends and enhanced undergraduate student financial assistance.

## DIRECTIONS

### **From Maryland - Traveling West**

Drive west on the Baltimore-Washington Parkway to the New York Avenue (Route 50) exit. Proceed on New York Avenue to Florida Avenue, NE, and turn right. Proceed to Georgia Avenue, NW and turn right again. Proceed north on Georgia Avenue to Howard Place, NW. Turn right and proceed to the Main Gate of Howard University.

### **From Maryland - Traveling South**

From Route 495 take Georgia Avenue, NW and proceed south (approximately 3 1/4 miles) to Howard Place, NW. Turn left and proceed to the Main Gate of Howard University.

### **From Maryland - Traveling North**

Follow Route 295 north across the 11th Street Bridge. Proceed through tunnel (Route 395 north) to New Jersey Avenue, NW. Follow New Jersey Avenue to Florida Avenue, NW. Turn left and proceed to Georgia Avenue, NW (approximately three blocks). Turn right and proceed north to Howard Place, NW. Turn right again and proceed to the Main Gate of Howard University.

### **From Virginia - Traveling East**

Follow Shirley Highway (Route 395) east through tunnel (Route 395 north) to New Jersey Avenue, NW. Follow New Jersey Avenue, to Florida Avenue, NW and turn left. Proceed to Georgia Avenue, NW (approximately three blocks). Turn right and proceed north on Georgia Avenue to Howard Place, NW. Turn right again and proceed to the Main Gate of Howard University.
