SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP) APPEAL FORM

Please complete this form if you wish to appeal a financial aid probation or suspension status.

If you failed to achieve SAP because of mitigating circumstances, you must submit the appeal form with a letter of explanation with any supporting documentation attached. Mitigating circumstances would include extreme illness or injury, family crisis, or death of an immediate family member. The circumstance must be documented. **NOTE: Submission of a SAP appeal does not guarantee reinstatement of aid eligibility.**

To complete the appeal process, you must complete all sections of this form. Attach your explanation and documentation that supports your circumstances (e.g., medical documentation, death certificate, doctor's certificate, or a letter from a counselor or social worker). Respond immediately if your appeal is returned to you because it is incomplete or if additional information is required. SAP appeal decisions will be sent via e-mail or postal mail within 7 – 10 business days from submission of completed appeals. All SAP appeal decisions are final.
