The five couples will be taken in a chauffeured-driven limousine to a candle-lit dinner at H2O Restaurant and Lounge and to a concert at the Warner Theatre, featuring R&B artist Lala Hathaway. To complete the evening, a dozen long-stemmed roses for the military couples, courtesy of Lee’s Flower and Card Shop.
