

ADVANCED STANDING PROGRAM *for* GRADUATES *of* ACCREDITED BACCALAUREATE SOCIAL WORK PROGRAMS

Howard University School of Social Work offers an *Advanced Standing Program for Graduates of Accredited Baccalaureate Social Work Programs*. This three semester program requires 45 credit hours for the Master of Social Work (MSW) degree. Four semesters and 60 credit hours are normally required. Students admitted to the advanced standing program must meet the following requirements:

- Degree from a baccalaureate social work program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE)
- Baccalaureate degree earned within four years of application to the MSW program
- Overall "B" average for undergraduate work
- Grades of "B" or better in social work core foundation courses:
 - Social Work Practice Methods
 - Field Instruction
 - Social Research
 - Human Behavior and the Social Environment
 - Social Welfare Policy and Services

Accepted applicants who meet the advanced standing program requirements will be granted advanced standing status upon enrollment in the MSW program.
