DR. JOHNETTA BETSCH COLE

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Charisse R. Lillie, Esq.

Dr. Johnnetta Betsch Cole was appointed director of the National Museum of African Art in March 2009. It is the only museum in the United States dedicated to the collection, conservation, study and exhibition of traditional and contemporary African art. The current collection of 9,000 objects represents nearly every area of the continent of Africa and contains a variety of media and art forms—textiles, photography, sculpture, pottery, painting, jewelry and video art—dating from ancient to contemporary times.

She serves on the Scholarly Advisory Board of the Smithsonian National Museum of African American History and Culture, and she has worked with a number of Smithsonian programs since the mid-1980s. She is the chairwoman of the board of the Johnnetta B. Cole Global Diversity and Inclusion Institute founded at Bennett College for Women in Greensboro, N.C. The nonprofit institute creates, communicates, and continuously supports the case for diversity and inclusion in the workplace and “the workplace” through education, training, research, and publications.

As president of Bennett College for Women from 2002-2007, she is credited with the revitalization of the revered institution. She completed a \$50 million capital campaign, opened an art gallery, and initiated programs in Africana women’s studies and

global studies. She served as Presidential Distinguished Professor of Anthropology, Women’s Studies and African American Studies, from 1998-2001 at Emory University. She was president of Spelman College in Atlanta from 1987-1997, and her appointment generated a \$20 million gift from Bill and Camille Cosby. Under her leadership, a \$113.8 million capital campaign was completed, and Spelman College was named the number-one ranked liberal arts college in the South.

She has conducted research in Africa, the Caribbean, and the United States and has authored several books and scores of scholarly articles. She has been awarded 54 honorary degrees from colleges and universities and won numerous awards. She is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the American Anthropological Association, having delivered its distinguished lecture in 2008. She serves on a number of boards, including TransAfrica Forum and The National Visionary Leadership Project.

She earned a doctorate degree (1967) and a master’s degree (1959) in anthropology from Northwestern University, and a bachelor’s degree (1957) in sociology from Oberlin College. She is married to James D. Staton, Jr.; they have three sons and two granddaughters.

MR. LAURENCE JOHN FISHBURNE III

Worldwide praise and acknowledgment of Laurence Fishburne’s work as actor/producer/director is renowned and a testament to the genius of his talent. He recently signed on to the CBS-TV hit prime-time show, “CSI: Crime Scene Investigation,” joining the cast as a former pathologist and traveling college lecturer who is now a level-one CSI. In addition, he has a first-look production deal, via his Cinema Gypsy Productions, with CBS Paramount Network Television. Cinema Gypsy film credits include *Akeelah and the Bee*, *Five Fingers*, *Always Outnumbered*, *Hoodlum*, and *Once in the Life*, which he wrote, directed, and starred. In 2008, he was featured in *Black Enterprise* magazine and identified as one of the “go to people” in Hollywood.

He was last seen in the box office success “21” with Kevin Spacey and also has several films in post-production and slated for upcoming release. These include *Days of Wrath* opposite Amber Valetta and Wilmer Valderrama, and *Tortured* with Cole Hauser and James Cromwell. He will also be seen in *Black Water Transit*, the story of the conflicting agendas of criminals, cops, and lawyers, and in *Armored*, a heist film involving the stealing of \$10 million. Most recently, he signed on to star, direct, and produce *The Alchemist* for The Weinstein Company. It is the story of Santiago, an Andalusian shepherd boy who yearns to travel in search of an extravagant worldly treasure.

Major film credits include: *Bobby*; *Mission Impossible III*; *Assault on Precinct 13* (with Ethan Hawke); *The Matrix: Reloaded*; *The Matrix: Revolutions*; *Mystic River* (directed by Clint Eastwood), with Sean Penn, Tim Robbins, Kevin Bacon, Marcia Gay Harden); *Biker Boyz*; *Event Horizon* (with Sam Neill, Kathleen Quinlan, Joely Richardson); *Miss Evers Boys*; *Fled*; *Othello*; *Bad*

Company (with Ellen Barkin); *Higher Learning* (written and directed by John Singleton, NAACP Award); *Just Cause* (with Sean Connery); *The Color Purple*; *Searching for Bobby Fischer*; *Deep Cover* (with Jeff Goldblum); *Boyz in the Hood* (written and directed by John Singleton); *Cadence* (directed by Martin Sheen); *Apocalypse Now*; *Cornbread, Earl and Me*; *Class Action*; *King of New York*; *Red Heat*; *Nightmare on Elm Street 3*; *Cotton Club*; and *Rumble Fish*.

He returned to Broadway in April 2008 for the one man show, “Thurgood,” about the life of renowned U.S. Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall, at the Booth Theatre. For this portrayal, he won both a Drama Desk Award and an Outer Critics Circle Award for Outstanding Solo Performance, and a Tony nomination for Best Performance by a Leading Actor in a Play. For his rare television performance in the 1993 premiere episode of “Tribeca” (Fox TV), he won an Emmy. And to complete a triple crown, he was nominated for an Oscar as Best Actor of 1993 for his portrayal of Ike Turner in the film, *What’s Love Got To Do With It*. In 1992, he was awarded a Tony for Best Featured Actor in a Play, a Drama Desk Award, an Outer Critics Circle Award, and a Theater World Award, all for his work on Broadway as Sterling Johnson in August Wilson’s “Two Trains Running.”

He continues to “pay it forward,” serving as an Ambassador for UNICEF, among several other benevolent efforts. In 2007, Harvard University honored him with the *Artist of the Year Award* for his outstanding contributions to American and International Performing Arts, as well as his many humanitarian contributions.

He is married to actress Gina Torres, and they have a daughter Delilah. He is also the father of teenagers, Langston and Montana.

HIS EXCELLENCY MR. FESTUS G. MOGAE, NYB, MCC, PH, MP
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Frank Savage
Chairman Emeritus, Board of Trustees

His Excellency Mr. Festus G. Mogae was president of Botswana from 1998 to 2008. Throughout his tenure, Botswana has grown in strength as a multi-party democracy, and is known worldwide for its wise management of abundant resources. It is one of Africa's richest countries and is a model for the Continent. In the area of HIV/AIDS, the current plague of Africa and the world, President Mogae led the way with enlightened national policies and practices, attracting attention and investment from the Gates Foundation and the Center for Disease Control, among others.

He conceived and initiated the building of a university of science and technology, reasoning that Africa and Botswana should not be left behind in the 21st century. He chose Howard University to forge a partnership in this endeavor, and the Botswana International University of Science and Technology (BIUST) is scheduled to open in 2010.

His career as a public officer began in 1968 as a planning officer. He was Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance and Development Planning from 1975 to 1976, and served in Washington, DC as Alternate and the Executive Director, International Monetary Fund for Anglophone Africa from 1976 to 1980. He was Governor of the Bank of Botswana from 1980 to 1981. From 1982 to 1989, he was Permanent Secretary to the

President, Secretary to the Cabinet, and Supervisor of Elections. He joined politics in 1989 and was appointed Minister of Finance and Development Planning and later became Vice President of the Republic of Botswana in 1992.

In October 2008, His Excellency Mogae was awarded the Mo Ibrahim Prize for Achievement in African Leadership and Good Governance. He has received a number of honors such as Naledi Ya Botswana - Gaborone (2003); Grand Croix - Madagascar (2006); Officier de l'Ordre Nationale du Mali (1977); Global Marketplace Award by the Corporate Council on Africa - Houston, TX (May 1999); Distinguished Achievement Award for AIDS Leadership in Southern Africa by the Medunsa Trust - Washington, DC, (June 2000); the 2002 Congressional Black Caucus Annual Legislative Conference Weekend Chairman's Award - Washington DC (September 2002); The Knight Commander of the Most Courteous Order of the Kingdom of Lesotho (2004); Honorary Fellow - University College Oxford (2003); to mention a few.

A native of Serowe in the Central District of Botswana, he studied economics at Oxford and Sussex universities in the United Kingdom, and earned a Bachelor of Arts with honors in Economics at Oxford.

He and his wife Barbara are the proud parents of three daughters.

MR. RONALD A. WILLIAMS

Ronald A. Williams is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Aetna Inc., a leading diversified health care benefits company which had revenue of approximately \$31.6 billion in 2007. Under his leadership, Aetna has sought to make a positive impact on health care in America by serving as a catalyst for change, focusing the industry, public policy leaders, physicians and employers on issues aimed at increasing access and affordability.

Since joining Aetna in 2001, he has focused on creating innovation in the industry, especially through information technology, and bringing new levels of transparency to the health care system. In September 2001, Aetna became the first national insurer to offer a consumer-directed health plan. In August 2005, it launched a new online consumer tool to view physician-specific price information, which was widely recognized as the beginning of a new era of transparency in the health care marketplace. More recently, the company led the effort to develop industry standards for electronic personal health records which provide a new way for consumers to be more engaged in their health care.

In 2002, he was named President and joined Aetna's Board. He was named CEO in February 2006 and Chairman of the Board in October 2006. Throughout his Aetna career, he has been outspoken in making the business case for quality in health care. He guided efforts to create Aetna's Aexcel network to provide access to cost-effective, quality care in high-cost specialties.

He is also a strong proponent of meaningful health care reform, and was an early advocate for an individual coverage requirement to expand access to health care and provide assistance

to the underserved. He has championed specific reforms in op-ed articles authored or co-authored in *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Washington Post*, *Financial Times*, and the *Seattle Post-Intelligencer*.

He lends his time and expertise to a number of organizations, such as the Council for Affordable Quality Healthcare, which he currently chairs. He is a trustee of The Conference Board and the Connecticut Science Center Board. In January 2007, he was elected to the Board of Directors of American Express Company, and in October 2008, he was elected a vice chairman of The Business Council. At the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, he serves on the MIT North America Executive Board. He is a member of the Alfred P. Sloan Management Society, Business Roundtable, International Federation of Health Plans, Healthcare Leadership Council, and National Intelligence Senior Advisory Group.

Prior to joining Aetna, he was Group President of the Large Group Division at WellPoint Health Networks Inc., and President of the company's Blue Cross of California subsidiary. He began at Blue Cross of California in 1987 and accepted a series of increasingly prominent roles. He was co-founder and Senior Vice President at Vista Health Corp., group marketing executive at Control Data Corp., and President and Co-Founder of Integrative Systems.

He is a graduate of Roosevelt University, and earned a Master of Science degree in Management from the Sloan School of Management at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He and his wife Cynthia have one son, Christopher, a senior at Eastern Connecticut State University.

MS. GWEN IFILL

A distinguished journalist for over three decades, Gwen Ifill is moderator and managing editor of “Washington Week” and senior correspondent for “The NewsHour with Jim Lehrer.” Now in its 40th year, “Washington Week” is the longest-running news and public affairs program on public television. It is broadcast by most of the 306 PBS stations nationwide and reaches 97 percent of U.S. households. She bolstered the program's journalistic roots and its commitment to presenting the reporters who actually cover the major weekly news stories. During the 2008 political campaign season, she took “Washington Week” to live audiences around the country as part of a 10-city tour.

She joined both “Washington Week” and “The NewsHour” in 1999, interviewing newsmakers and reporting on issues ranging from foreign affairs to politics. She is frequently asked to moderate debates in national elections, including the Vice Presidential debates during the 2004 and 2008 elections. Also, she is the author of the bestseller, “The Breakthrough: Politics in the Age of Obama.”

Before coming to PBS, she spent five years at NBC News as chief congressional and political correspondent, and still appears as an occasional roundtable panelist on “Meet The Press.” She joined NBC News from *The New York Times* where she covered the White House and politics. She also covered national and local affairs for *The Washington Post*, *Baltimore Evening Sun*, and *Boston Herald American*. “I always knew I wanted to be a journalist, and my first love was newspapers,” she said. “But public broadcasting provides the best of both worlds—combining the depth of newspapering with the immediate impact of broadcast television.”

A native of New York City and a graduate of Simmons College in Boston, she has received more than a dozen honorary doctorates and is the recipient of several broadcasting excellence awards. She serves on the board of the Harvard University Institute of Politics, the Committee to Protect Journalists, the Newseum, and the Philip Merrill College of Journalism at the University of Maryland.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1997. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these six Schools and Colleges. The next five Schools and Colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate-level programs exclusively.

THE MACE

The mace is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Professor of Engineering and Director of the Howard Nanoscale Science and Engineering Facility (HNF). One of the earliest visual images of the mace is the front-side of the “Narmer Palette” of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt *circa* 3100 B.C., ushering in the great pyramid building of the old kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today’s Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

The batons carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with red, white and blue ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master’s degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and Master’s gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today’s procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

THE HONORS MEDAL AND HONORS CORDS

The Honors Medal is worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, or *summa cum laude* honors. The Medal and Honors Cords symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University –“Truth and Service.” Encircling the seal is the phrase, “Honors Graduate and Leadership for America,” which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honors Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of *magna cum laude*. The gold Honors Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of *summa cum laude*.

THE TORCH PIN

The Torch Pin symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, “Howard University – Bearers of the Torch,” which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDALS

The University's Honorary Degree Medals worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients were formally presented to them at the annual “President's Dinner” held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's 141st Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Ribeau, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee Emeritus, Herman B Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.

LIFT EVERY VOICE AND SING
