

Human Body Fluids

- Notify the Campus Police Department at 202-806-1100 in the event of exposure to human body fluids.
Remember human blood may carry blood borne pathogens, which can cause disease.
- If contact is made with skin, wash the area immediately with soap and water
- Do not attempt to clean fluids unless properly trained and equipped.
- Always use rubber or latex gloves when in the proximity of bodily fluids and consider them infectious.
- Gloves that have been in contact with bodily fluids must be disposed of in a biohazard container and hands must be washed with soap and water.
