Safety Alert

An Armed Robbery has been reported in the area of the Howard University Hospital. Police are alerting and requesting assistance from the Howard community in locating the suspect and witnesses. The victim was robbed of cash and personal property.

The suspect in this incident is described as:

Black male, light complexion, approximately forty years of age, 5' 8", small build, wearing a yellow hoody jacket, blue jeans and armed with a 10" kitchen knife

Students, faculty and staff are advised to be aware of their surroundings when traveling on foot, especially during hours of darkness. The Shuttle Service, Student Escort Service or Employee Escort for HUH employees parked on Howard property should be utilized whenever possible. Members of the Howard Community are reminded of the following:

- 1. WALK WITH A GROUP, IF POSSIBLE**
- 2. AVOID DARK OR POORLY LIT AREAS**
- 3. LIMIT, REMOVE OR HIDE EXPENSIVE JEWELRY**
- 4. DON'T CARRY LARGE SUMS OF CASH**
- 5. DON'T TAKE SHORTCUTS THROUGH TUNNELS, PARKING LOTS, OR ALLEYS**

IN THE EVENT YOU ARE A VICTIM, DO NOT RESIST. COOPERATE AND FOLLOW THE PERPERTRATOR'S INSTUCTIONS. DO NOT RISK GETTING SERIOUSLY HURT FOR MATERIAL ITEMS.

REPORT ALL CRIME AND SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY TO CAMPUS POLICE.
